DWS GROUP COOKIE POLICY

Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how DWS Group (DWS) uses cookies and similar technologies on our websites and web applications. This policy outlines the types of cookies we use, the purposes for which they are used, and how you can control their use. Please read this policy carefully to understand how we use cookies and how you can manage them.

Scope

This Cookie Policy applies to the websites and web applications operated by DWS, which may include:

• Our **internal systems** used for timesheet management, reporting, and other business operations.

• Our external website(s), which are publicly accessible.

This policy applies to cookies used on our own digital platforms but **does not apply to thirdparty websites or services**. For example, if you interact with links or embedded content from external sources (such as social media platforms, third-party tools, or services integrated with our website), those services will have their own cookie policies, and we are not responsible for their cookies.

You should review the privacy and cookie policies of those third-party services independently. We use trusted third-party platforms and cloud services to host certain aspects of our systems, but we do not share specific technical details about these platforms in this policy for security reasons.

However, these platforms may set their own cookies as part of their service delivery. We recommend reviewing the cookie policies of these third-party platforms if you are concerned about their use of cookies.

Cookies

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device when you visit a website or use a web application. They are widely used to make websites and applications work, as well as to enhance performance and provide a better user experience.

There are different types of cookies:

• Session Cookies: These are temporary cookies that are erased from your device when you close your browser.

- Persistent Cookies: These remain on your device until they expire, or you delete them.
- First-Party Cookies: Set by the website or web application you are visiting.

• **Third-Party Cookies**: Set by other organisations, typically for analytics or advertising purposes.

Cookies We Use

Our web applications and websites may use the following types of cookies:

Essential Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the operation of our websites and web applications. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of the web applications, such as our internal timesheet or reporting system. Without these cookies, these services cannot function properly.

Functional Cookies

These cookies allow us to remember choices you make (such as your language preferences or login details) and provide enhanced, more personalised features. These cookies are not essential for the core functionality of our websites, but they improve your experience.

Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies collect information about how users interact with our websites and web applications, such as the pages they visit and any errors they encounter. We use these cookies to improve the performance and functionality of our services, but they do not collect personal data that can identify you. These cookies are typically set by third-party services. Our external DWS website may use cookies for basic analytics and to track performance metrics. We do not intentionally use cookies for advertising, targeted marketing, or other purposes outside of what is described above.

How We Manage Cookies

You can control and manage cookies through your browser settings. Most browsers allow you to:

- Accept or reject cookies.
- Delete cookies.
- Receive notifications when a cookie is set.

However, please note that if you disable cookies, some features of our web applications and websites may not work as intended.
